B1 The future of humanity

Instruction: Follow these general guidelines. Use the links provided on the syllabus website. Underlined items are links to ADDITIONAL support.

<u>Aims</u>

Stage 1

- Click on the **Stage 1** link. Play the video. Pause after each sentence has disappeared from the screen. Ask students to say the sentence exactly in the same way it was shown on the video. You may need to go back to display the sentence again.
- Play the video again (the future predictions part) and ask students to remember as many predictions as possible. In pairs, they say what the world will look like in 2100.

Stage 2

- Click on the **Stage 2** link. Scroll through the text displaying the headings only. Explain new vocabulary.
- Slowly scroll down again and ask students to make a note of all the horrible things that will happen in the future.
- Game: Ask individual students to say a prediction about the future. Tell them if they are an optimist and pessimist first. Go one by one; if a student fails to come up with a prediction he/she is out but they can help a student sitting next to them in the next round.
- Discussion: What must humanity do to make sure only the positive predictions come true.
